ALARM SYSTEM CHANGE

The theatre has recently upgraded our security by getting our alarm system monitored. This means that when the alarm system goes off a security guard will be sent out to investigate.

This will eliminate the early hours of the morning phone calls and trips to the theatre so many have done for so many years and increase personal safety.

Reminders...

Keep it clean... Please remember that it is the current show's responsibility to keep the theatre clean during rehearsals and to do a thorough clean-up just prior to opening night. This includes the auditorium and toilets. The public areas will then be maintained by the Front of House staff.

Smoking... Please remember it is a theatre rule that there is no smoking at least 5 metres from any entrance. Please do not be offended if you are reminded of this ☺
