President's Report

There is some positive news to report this month. The Electrical up-grade that we have been urgently waiting for has finally commenced. As you were all aware the Theatre's electrical system was not up to the BCA requirements. The City of Armadale has spent over \$30,000.00 to put this right.

So far the work that has been carried out has been the following. New Emergency Lighting has been installed in the Bio Box, Entry, Men's & Women's Toilets. A mains powered smoke detector has been fitted in the Green Room. All the wiring in the Bio Box has been wired to a new circuit. R.C.D's (Residual Current Device) has been fitted to all power circuits. Vandal Proof Flourescents have been fitted externally & these are fitted with P.E Cells. (Lights come on when the sun goes down). Also new sensors for external lights have been fitted. For me personally this is welcome news as the electrics were not in good shape. Work is still continuing & I will give you a full run down on completion.

We are still in negotiation on re-wiring the Auditorium with the Council & hopefully a date will be set later this year. Also the Tin Roof has to be replaced at the same time. We also have had some Quotes on the New Patio & will make a decision soon.

The City of Armadale have also given us funds to purchase new carpet for the Foyer. They are keen for this to go ahead soon. I have received a call from Mark from the Canning Floor Covering Centre and will soon be choosing new floor coverings. Also the council have budgeted for Painting as well and this will enable us to get the men's toilets completed. We are so lucky with the council. They have been excellent to deal with & to be offered these funds is truly amazing. They can see that we take great pride in our Theatre.

I will be reporting to you all at our General Meeting to be held on the 19th of October. Thank you all for all of your support & I will see you all at the Theatre.


